



Government Guidance on Business Support Schemes for Corona Virus – 7th May 2020

Self-Employment Income Support Scheme (SEISS)

Dear Client,

The grant scheme for Income Support based on 80% of your self-assessment income will open on the 13th May. We recognise a lot of people have been waiting for this one, so to prepare you, there are some things you need to do ahead of time:

- 2. Apply on-line now to see if you are eligible. Here is a link for you:

- **3.** HMRC are likely to stagger the dates you can apply, so make a note of the date you can apply.
- **4.** Prepare all the information you need beforehand and make sure you have it when you apply

Some questions we have received which answer questions on eligibility:

- To qualify, you have to confirm your business has been adversely impacted by the Corona Virus. There is no definition for this, but some other schemes look for a 40% reduction in turnover since the pandemic (i.e. March/ April 2020)
- There has to be a reduction in your work. This means you can still be working, but not earning the same level of income as before.
- Income from self-employment has to be your main source of income
- The application will be capped to £7,500. This is three months at the maximum allowable amount of £2,500 per month
- You have to have filed a self-assessment for the year to 5th April 2019
